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## These notes will help you understand how we have worked out your tax code(s)

Note 1 Personal Allowance		This is the standard amount of taxable income most people can have before they start paying Income Tax. If your total income exceeds £100000, your allowance goes down proportionally.	
Note 2	Other Earnings	We use your tax-free allowances against your other income so you pay tax on this.	
Note 3	Property Income	This is the rental income that you get from property or land. We use your tax-free allowances against this income so you pay tax on this.	
Note 4	Untaxed Interest	This is interest paid to you before tax is taken off. We have reduced your tax-free allowance so you pay tax on this income.	
Note 5	Dividend Tax	This is to collect the basic rate of tax due on your dividend income.	
Note 6	Tax Code L	Shows you are entitled to the standard tax-free Personal Allowance.	
Note 7 Ta	Tax-free amount	To create your tax code, we've removed the last digit of you tax-free amount and included a letter. If you have more that source of income, your tax-free amount may be split across these. We tell your employer(s) or pension provider(s) your code but we do not tell them how we worked it out.
