Diagnosis:

Metastatic melanoma stage IV with left axillary nodal and liver metastases, with indeterminate left lung lesion, BRAF negative.

- Primary excised from the left mid back 26th August 2021-superficial spreading malignant melanoma Breslow thickness 3 mm, pT3a.

Treatment plan:

Palliative combination immunotherapy with Ipilimumab and Nivolumab commenced on the 11th September 2023.

October 2023 - developed grade 2 immune nephritis and grade 1 immune hepatitis following one cycle Ipi/Nivo immunotherapy. On weaning dose of Prednisolone with a complete reversal of side-effects.

December 2023 - commenced maintenance Nivolumab 4 weekly. Clinical response evident.

I have reviewed Paul along with his partner today. Paul has now had 2 cycles of maintenance 4 weekly Nivolumab immunotherapy and appears to be coping reasonably well with no significant side-effects. He has noticed bilateral pitting pedal oedema, which is likely secondary to his nephritis and the significant amount of oral fluid intake he is currently trying to maintain.

Clinically he has noticed his left axillary lymph node has started to respond with decrease in size (it was increasing in size whilst he was on steroids for nephritis). He does not show any
