



Changes to tariff price & terms and conditions of supply

Dear Customer,

Tariff price change

Due to significant increases in the price we pay for wholesale energy and other costs, we have regrettably had to make the difficult decision to increase prices (effective 1st July 2013 [1]). This will add £1.73 per week for a typical household as a result of the 17.8% increase [2].

There is never a good time to increase prices and it is something we do reluctantly. We were able to cut our prices by over 14% last year when many other electricity suppliers in the UK were raising theirs and we will always look for opportunities to reduce prices again should circumstances allow.

There is no need to contact us as a result of this tariff price change, as the new tariff will be automatically applied to your account.

We cannot control external wholesale energy costs, but we can help our customers save money on their electricity - and we are doing so. Please see the enclosed leaflet for details of the change and how you can benefit from our discounted payment options.

Terms and conditions change

Power NI's terms and conditions of supply are changing, including the way in which we use your personal data. Please see the enclosed leaflet for more information.

[2] 'Typical' based on 3,300 units used in a year at Power NI standard rate. 'Typical' Economy 7, based on 8,100 units (34% day 66% night), will increase by £2.82 per week.
