Option 2:

Not using your vehicle?

If your vehicle is being kept off the road and you don't want to tax it, you must tell us by making a SORN (Statutory Off Road Notification). You can do this by using the reference number above at www.gov.uk/make-a-sorn or phone 0300 123 4321.



Option 3:

No longer have the vehicle?

The quickest way to tell us is online at www.gov. uk/sold-bought-vehicle
Alternatively, send the V5C registration certificate (log book) or a signed letter to DVLA, Swansea, SA99
1BD giving the registration number, make, model, date it was sold and new keeper details. We can't take this information by phone.
