These considerable changes in gas, electricity rates and standing charges mean the estimated annual energy bill will rise by an average of 54%. This is an estimated figure - every household will be different depending on the amount of energy used and how you pay. At this time, your current Standard Variable tariff is still our cheapest available. All variable tariffs, regardless of supplier, will not be above Ofgem's energy price cap.

There's nothing you need to do - you'll be switched to the new rates automatically from 1st April.

We understand that everyone's circumstances are different and that some may find this price increase especially difficult. We're here to help.
