Scheme Administrator identification number (Scheme Administrator ID)

You have been pre-registered as a Scheme Administrator for Pension Schemes Online.

Go to www.hmrc.gov.uk and select 'Pension Schemes' under 'do it online' to register and activate the service.

You will need:

- your activation token which appeared on screen when you completed pre-registration, and
- your Scheme Administrator ID.

Your Scheme Administrator ID is A0129609

You will need your Scheme Administrator ID:

- to register for Pension Schemes Online. Once registered, you will not need it again to access Pension Schemes Online. However, if you want to be recorded as the Scheme Administrator of a particular pension scheme and we already have a Scheme Administrator recorded against that scheme, you will need to give that Scheme Administrator your ID so they can associate you to the scheme. Once they have done so, you should log on to Pension Schemes Online and select 'add yourself as Scheme Administrator' under 'Select an action'
- if you have a practitioner and they will be filing information on your behalf. You will need to provide them with your Scheme Administrator ID to ensure the submission is attached to the correct record.
